Minutes of the meeting with Director(i/c) SOPVA for organising Student Support Services of Diploma in Theatre Arts (DTH)

Date: 21st March, 2022

Background: For the academic session January and July 2021, the enrolment for Diploma in Theatre Arts (DTH) has been low in some Study Centres. The Regional Centre wise enrolment is given in following table:

The low enrolment has posed a serious constraint in the organisation of counselling sessions at the level of Regional Centres.

Theory counselling sessions for this programme have already been organised online by School of Performing and Visual Arts (SOPVA). However, the faculty of SOPVA feels that practical counselling for theatre cannot be done through online platforms. Another option of holding practical counselling (through F2F mode) at different RCs is not feasible due to following reasons:

- The financial commitments for practical counselling (through F2F mode) if organised in different RCs will be very high due to low enrolment
- The organisation of the practical counselling for theatre programme involves group work which cannot be done due to low enrolment.

Therefore SOPVA, vide note dated 17th March 2022 approved by PVC(SK) has suggested a provision of organising workshop (in lieu of practical counselling) for all the students at SOPVA. IGNOU HQs. Matter has been brought to RSD for devising an implementation scheme for this arrangement. In order to plan the implementation a meeting of Director (i/c) SOPVA and officials of RSD was organised.

Deliberations and Discussions

The underlying issues were described in detail and following scheme was planned to implement the workshop-based practicals.

- All the students will be attached to LSC-07187P for the purpose of Workshop. The schedule of the Workshop will be planned by SOPVA and will be communicated to the students by the Programme Coordinator, DTH. **Action: SOPVA**
- The schedule will also be uploaded on the web site of Regional Centre. **Action: Regional Centre**
- The workshop will be conducted by SOPVA and Award Lists will be informed to SED directly. **Action: SOPVA**
- The workshop will be recorded and recording will be made available for the benefit of prospective learners. It will be done in the Convention Centre, IGNOU Hqtrs. with support from EMPC. **Action: SOPVA, EMPC**
- The expenditure incurred on Support Services provided by the LSC-07187P will be borne by RC Delhi-1. **Action: RC Delhi-1**

Sub: Guidelines for Conducting Workshop for Practical Courses of Diploma in Theatre Arts

The School of Performing and Visual Arts (SOPVA) has launched the Diploma in Theatre Arts (DTH) programme from January 2021 session. In some of the study centres spread over 16 Regional Centres (RC) the enrolment has been observed to be low (Annexure-1). In order to provide support services to the learners of the low enrolment centres, the following scheme has been planned:

- SOPVA will be organizing a 7-10 days workshop for the 39 learners (January 2021& July 2021) for completion of the practical courses of DTH.
- The workshop will be conducted in the LSC 07187(P) located in SOPVA, by the approved academic counsellors and SOPVA Faculty.
- All the students will be attached to LSC-07187P for the purpose of Workshop. The schedule of the Workshop will be planned by SOPVA and will be communicated to the students by the Programme Coordinator, DTH, at least one month before the commencement of the workshop.
- The schedule will also be uploaded on the web site of Regional Centre
- After completion of the workshop the learners will appear for their practical exams at LSC 07187(P), along with registered learners of RCs in Delhi-NCR.
- The Award Lists will be informed to SED directly by SOPVA
- The workshop will be recorded and recording will be made available for the benefit of prospective learners. It will be done in the Convention Centre, IGNOU Hqtrs. with support from EMPC.
- The expenditure incurred on Support Services provided by the LSC-07187P, will be borne by RC Delhi-1.
